COMPETITION RULES

"MIODRAG AZANJAC" INTERNATIONAL FLUTE COMPETITION Belgrade, March 19 – 22, 2020.

Article 1.

The <u>Elementary Music School</u> "Vladimir <u>Djordjevic" of Belgrade (Serbia)</u> in collaboration with the <u>Flute Association of Serbia</u> "Miodrag Azanjac", organize the <u>III International Flute Competition</u> "Miodrag Azanjac".

Article 2.

The event is addressed to students coming from public and private music schools/academies worldwide.

Article 3.

The competition will be held in the **Elementary Music School "Vladimir Djordjevic"**, V. Jagica 5, Belgrade (Serbia) **from 19th to 22nd of March, 2020.**

Article 4.

COMPETITION PROPOSITIONS

Candidates of all categories perform **free choice program**, within given time limit. At least **one composition** must be played **from memory.**

Categories and performance duration

Junior category A (born in 2011. and younger) – up to 5 minutes Junior category B (born in 2009. and younger) – up to 5 minutes I category (born in 2007. and younger) – up to 8 minutes II category (born in 2005. and younger) – up to 12 minutes III category (born in 2003. and younger) – up to 20 minutes IV category (born in 2001. and younger) – up to 25 minutes V category (born in 2000. and older) – up to 30 minutes

Note: Students attending higher stage of education can't compete with students/pupils attending lower stage of education. They have to perform in the next category, comprised of older contestants, regardless of their birth date.

Article 5.

To enter the competition, candidates will have to complete the required **online application form**, given at the official School website **www.vladimirdjordjevic.edu.rs**

On the day of the Competition, candidates have to show evidence of their <u>birth</u> <u>date</u>, as well as copy of the <u>payment receipt for the registration fee</u> (showing candidate's name and last name) to the Competition secretary.

Article 6.

<u>APPLICATION DEADLINE</u> - February 20, 2020.



Article 7. Registration (Donation) Fees

Junior categories – 2.500 RSD. Categories I and II – 3.500 RSD. Categories III and IV – 4.000 RSD. Category V – 4.500 RSD.


Candidates from other countries should pay their donations when they arrive to Serbia (on the day of Competition).

All donations must be paid to Bank Account of the Flute Association of Serbia, account number: **205-65542-81**, purpose of payment: "Donation for flute competition".

In the case of candidate's cancellation, the Organizer is not obliged to return the fee payment.

Article 8.Prizes

1st prize: 95 – 100 points 2nd prize: 85 – 94.99 points 3rd prize: 75 – 84.99 points





In case that two or more candidates obtain the same number of points, younger candidate will have the advantage.

<u>In each category</u> which has more than one competitor, the competitor obtaining the highest score (and minimum 95 points), will be awarded with special prize named *Laureate of the Category*.

Among Category Laureates from Junior category A and B, I and II category, jury will choose **one candidate**, who will be awarded with special prize named *Elementary Music School Laureate*.

Among Category Laureates from III and IV category, jury will choose one candidate, who will be awarded with special prize named Secondary Music School Laureate.

In addition to diploma, Laureates may be awarded by cup, as well as other gifts provided by competition's sponsors. Additional awards and gifts are subject to change without notice.

Article 9.

Some of the winners of the first prizes of each category may participate in the final concert, open to the public, and will execute the pieces chosen by the jury.

Article 10.

The **Jury** of Competition will comprise of outstanding Serbian and foreign flute pedagogues, whose names will be published on our web site one month before the start of the Competition.

Article 11.

Travel expenses, board and lodging are at the candidates charge.

Article 12.

The Organizer will provide an official piano accompanist, if required by candidate and marked in application form. In that case, candidate is required to send scanned piano score to oms.vldj@mts.rs. This service will be charged an additional fee, in agreement with the Organizer.

Article 13.

The organizer reserves the right to acquire and publish audiovisual material during the Competition, without any compensation for the participants.

Article 14.

The organizer is not responsible for any risks, injuries or damages of any kind suffered by participants during the event.
